- Soak in Reykjavik's famous Blue Lagoon, a soothing 98-104 degrees year-round.
- Sample "Viking sushi," which is fermented shark, and the national dish of Iceland.
- Witness the rainbow-colored beauty of Godafoss, the "Waterfall of the Gods," outside Akureyri.
- Take a polar flight to Grimsey Island where you can stand with one foot in the Arctic Circle.
- Visit the island of Heimaey, the Pompeii of the North, covered in ash by a devastating 1973 eruption.
- Meet friendly Icelandic horses brought to the island by the Vikings in the 9th or 10th century A.D.
- Overnights in Seydisfjordur with its colorful historic houses imported from Norway by wealthy 20th century merchants.
- Sail past Surtsey Island, the youngest place on earth, created by an eruption in 1963.
